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## LING 602 Topics in Sociolinguistics

**Credits 3. 3 Lecture Hours.** Topics in the study of language and society; may focus on language use and change; how social variable affect language use and change; different theoretical approaches; issues and controversies. May be taken three times for credit as content varies.

## LING 610/ENGL 610 Topics in the History of the English Language

**Credits 3. 3 Lecture Hours.** Topics in the development of the English language; may include phonological, grammatical and lexical histories; study of social and political contexts; relationships between English and other languages. May be taken three times for credit as content varies.
