Residence

Distance Education Degree Program

There is no residence requirement for the Master of Science in Education for Health Care Professionals.

Continuous Registration

Coursework on his or her degree plan is required to be in continuous registration until all requirements for the degree have been completed.

Time Limit

All degree requirements must be completed within a period of seven consecutive years for the degree to be granted. A course will be considered valid until seven years after the end of the semester in which it is taken. Graduate credit for coursework which is more than seven calendar years old at the time of the final examination (oral or written) may not be used to satisfy degree requirements.
