A grade of C or higher is required for a course to be counted in the major. For residency, a student must have at least 12 hours in 300- or 400-level English classes from Texas A&M University.

The program includes a total of 150 hours, of which up to 0 hours of graduate-level coursework may be applied toward both the Bachelor of Arts in English and the Master of Arts in English (thesis).

College and University Requirements

Graduation requirements include 3 hours of International and Cultural Diversity (http://catalog.tamu.edu/undergraduate/generalinformation/degree-information/international-cultural-diversityrequirements/) courses and 3 hours of Cultural Discourse (http:// catalog.tamu.edu/undergraduate/general-information/degreeinformation/cultural-discourse-requirements/) courses. A course satisfying a Core category, a college/department requirement, or a free elective can be used to satisfy this requirement. The required 6 hours may be met by courses satisfying other areas of a degree program. See your academic advisor for further information.

Other courses may qualify for the following categories. All courses are to be selected with the approval of the student's academic advisor. The courses incorporate University Core Curriculum (http:// catalog.tamu.edu/undergraduate/general-information/universitycore-curriculum/) requirements. No course can be counted in more than one category, except as allowed in the minor field of study and the International and Cultural Diversity (http://catalog.tamu.edu/ undergraduate/general-information/degree-information/internationalcultural-diversity-requirements/) and Cultural Discourse (http:// catalog.tamu.edu/undergraduate/general-information/degreeinformation/cultural-discourse-requirements/) graduation requirements. A minimum of 36 hours of 300- or 400-level coursework must be completed at Texas A&M University, with at least 12 of those hours being in the major.
