

TRADING, RISK AND INVESTMENTS - CERTIFICATE

This program is designed to prepare BBA FINC and BBA Business Honors/FINC undergraduate students in the fields of energy trading, investments, and risk management by combining exceptional class instruction with hands-on internship-based experience.

The Adam C. Sinn '00 Department of Finance (<https://mays.tamu.edu/departments/finance/>) offers specialized study through the Trading, Risk and Investments Program (TRIP). Three paid internships with different board member companies are required and provided. TRIP students must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.

Students who pursue TRIP must complete all program requirements prior to graduation. Upon graduation a certificate notation will be added to the official transcript.
