ART - MINOR

This minor provides students with a prevalent view of the world of art.

A broad orientation to the visual arts is offered by the College of Performance, Visualization and Fine Arts to non-Visualization majors. Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 with 70 or fewer credit hours completed to apply and must maintain a C average or better in all Art minor courses. The student's home school/college/department may grant, with agreement from the College of Performance, Visualization and Fine Arts, transfer credit of no more than 6 credit hours. Transfer credit will not be accepted for any 300- or 400-level courses. Credit for study abroad (CARC) courses may not be applied to the minor in Art if an on-campus course containing similar content is offered.

Per University guidelines, the student's home school/college/department is responsible for advising students pursuing the minor in Art.
