- Complete 14 hours of a foreign language (http://catalog.tamu.edu/undergraduate/government-public-service/) through the intermediate level. If you choose to enroll in a language you have studied previously without receiving college credit, you must first take a placement test. Select in consultation with an academic advisor.
- At least 3 hours must be in MATH except MATH 102, MATH 150, MATH 167, STAT 201. Three hours may be PHIL 240.
- Select from any 100-499 course not used elsewhere including BUSH 632, BUSH 635, PSAA 630, PSAA 622, PSAA 634; 6hours PSAA 600-699 (http://catalog.tamu.edu/graduate/course-descriptions/ psaa/); (excluding POLS 100-499 (http://catalog.tamu.edu/ undergraduate/course-descriptions/pols/))
- Students must complete this course before taking more than 6 hours of 300- or 400-level courses in Political Science.
- Select from POLS 100-499 (exclude POLS 206, POLS 207, POLS 209, POLS 308-POLS 309); BUSH 631; PSAA 601, PSAA 611, PSAA 621.

- Course counted towards the Political Science electives of the BA program.
- BUSH school graduate advisor will assist with BUSH/PSAA course selection for chosen track in the graduate program.

No more than 36 credits in political science may be applied to the degree.

A grade of C or better is required for a course to be counted in the major field.

Other courses may qualify for the college and university requirements. Student should consult the approved list of courses in the Undergraduate Student Services Office. No course can be counted in more than one category.

Students are reclassified as degree seeking master's students typically in the second year of the graduate portion of this program.

The program includes a total of 168 hours which up to 18 hours may be applied toward both the Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and the Master of Public Service Administration.
